



1. Regular Season & Data Collection

- As games proceed, the official scorekeepers update GameChanger with stats. Managers observe player performance and note intangible qualities for their evaluations.

2. Managers Complete Evaluation Forms

- Each Manager fills out standardized forms (skills and intangibles) for eligible players (and may consult assistant coaches).
- These forms provide qualitative insight: leadership, teamwork, effort, etc.

3. Commissioner & Player Agent Review

- They examine both GameChanger data (hitting, pitching, fielding, etc.) and Manager Evaluations to form an overall view of each eligible player's strengths.

4. Preliminary Shortlist (~20)

- Using those combined data points, the Commissioner and Player Agent create a list of about 20 standout players who warrant deeper consideration.

5. Shortlist Presented to President & Vice President

- The President and Vice President review the proposed shortlist.
- They approve or suggest adjustments, and determine which All-Star teams Interbay Little League will field (e.g., age divisions, availability of players).

6. Selection Meeting

- Attended by the Commissioner, Player Agent, and all Managers who have at least one player on the shortlist.
- Managers receive concise "Player Profiles" summarizing stats, evaluation scores, and notable points (injuries, leadership, etc.).

7. Vote & Discussion

- Managers cast votes anonymously for their top choices.
- Any ties or borderline cases are revisited; the Commissioner and Player Agent have final say if deadlocks remain.

8. Final Team Announcement

- The final 12 (or appropriate roster size) is determined.
- After District approval, the All-Star team is publicly announced, and the league celebrates the achievement of the selected players.
